Mr. Mumma noted that the hearing was advertised in accordance with rules and regulations of the CDBG program. The Borough held a public hearing on July 16, 2014 to solicit the views of citizens on the types of projects which should be carried out with the 2014 CDBG program funds. The Borough anticipates receiving a grant of \$134,046 in FY 2014 CDBG funds, and has determined that the best use of these funds would be for the following activities:

- 1. Street Improvements \$109,918
 - Ridge Avenue from W. Second Street to W. Third Street
 - Hamilton Avenue from W. Second Street to W. Third Street
 - Clyde Street from Brown Street to Eden Avenue
- 2. Administration \$24,128

Karen Parish of Mullin and Lonergan Associates (the Borough's community development block grant consultants) was present to further explain the program and proposed projects, and answer any questions.

Input from the public was requested, however no one voiced any comments.

Hearing no further questions or comments, the hearing closed at 7:20 p.m.
