Notice is hereby given that Borough Council of the Borough of Waynesboro, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, intends to consider for adoption and to vote upon the enactment of the ordinance summarized below at the regularly scheduled meeting on April 17, 2024, at 6:30 PM in the second floor Council Chambers of Borough Hall located at 55 East Main Street, Waynesboro, Pennsylvania.

The title of the proposed ordinance is as follows: **“AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF WAYNESBORO, FRANKLIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING CHAPTER 195 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF WAYNESBORO TO CLARIFY LICENSE FEE EXEMPTION REQUIREMENTS.”**

If enacted, the proposed ordinance will amend Chapter 195 of the Code of the Borough of Waynesboro to clarify license fee exemption requirements for transient vendors in the Borough of Waynesboro. Anyone claiming or seeking an exemption from license fees required by Chapter 195 shall provide dispositive proof of such exemption to the Borough Manager or his designee at the time of application for the license required by said Chapter.
