

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
BOROUGH OF WAYNESBORO, PA
FY 2024 CDBG PROGRAM**

Notice is hereby given by the Borough of Waynesboro that a Public Hearing will be held on October 10, 2024 at 3:00 PM prevailing time, in the Waynesboro Borough Council Chambers on the second floor of the Borough Building, located at 55 E. Main Street, Waynesboro, PA 17268. The Borough Building and the Council Chambers are accessible to the physically disabled. The purpose of the Public Hearing is to present the Borough's Proposed FY 2024 CDBG Application and the use of CDBG funds. A copy of the Borough's Proposed Application is available for public review in the office of the Borough Manager, beginning on October 3, 2024, for a period of at least 5 days prior to the Public Hearing. The office of the Borough Manager is open to the public between the hours of 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM, weekdays.

The Borough proposes to use the FY 2024 CDBG Program funds for the following activities:

Activity & Proposed Budgets

1. Street Improvements:	\$138,319.00
<ul style="list-style-type: none">Funds will be used for the improvement and reconstruction of Tritle Avenue from W. Main Street to King Street. This is a multi-year activity with FY 2025 CDBG funds.	
2. General Administration:	\$ 30,362.00
<ul style="list-style-type: none">General administrative costs, including preparation of application, the environmental review record, advertising, audit, planning and management.	
TOTAL	\$168,681.00

If the Borough would undertake the acquisition, demolition, and/or rehabilitation of residential properties that could result in displacement of families or individuals, then the Borough's policy for minimizing such displacement would be in effect. The Borough is responsible for replacing all low- and moderate-income housing units that may be demolished or converted as a result of the use of CDBG funds.

All interested residents are encouraged to attend and will be afforded the opportunity to give oral testimony at the Public Hearing and/or to present written comments concerning the proposed FY 2024 CDBG Program Application of the Borough of Waynesboro.
