



Attention Borough Residents: Proper Snow Removal Required

To maintain a safe and walkable community, please follow these guidelines:

1. Clear Your Sidewalk Promptly

- After a storm ends, **you have 24 hours** to remove snow, ice, sleet, mud, or similar substances from your sidewalk.

2. Keep Streets and Hydrants Clear

- Do **NOT** place snow or ice in the street or in areas already cleared by plows.
- Keep at least **3 feet of space around fire hydrants**.

3. Why It Matters

- Clear sidewalks help prevent slips and falls and ensure safe passage for pedestrians, including children and seniors.

4. What Happens If You Don't Comply

- Owners who do not comply may face a **\$75 fine per violation**, plus court costs and attorney fees.
- Each day after the first 24 hours counts as a **separate violation**.
- The Borough may remove the snow or ice and charge the cost to the property owner.
