SPECIAL MEETING

Council President C. Harold Mumma called the special meeting of the Waynesboro Borough Council to order at 6:30 p.m. with the following in attendance:

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE: Mayor Starliper led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

PUBLIC COMMENTS – AGENDA ITEMS: Visitors desiring to comment on a particular agenda item will be recognized by the President to speak when the topic is being discussed.

PUBLIC COMMENTS – NON-AGENDA ITEMS: None.

NEW BUSINESS

AWARD BID FOR 2021 CDBG STREET PROJECT (W. THIRD STREET FROM FAIRVIEW AVENUE TO S. PRICE AVENUE) TO RECON CONSTRUCTION SERVICES, INC.: Kevin Grubbs provided Council members with information regarding the proposal from RECON Construction Services for the 2021 CDBG Street Project (W. Third Street from Fairview Avenue to S. Price Avenue). Their bid was for \$173,052.50 and the staff is recommending award of the contract. Mr. Grubbs added that their anticipated start date would be late-July or early-August, and the work will be completed prior to the start of school. RECON will also provide all necessary traffic control for arrival and dismissal at the school.

Councilman Cermak made a motion for approval. Councilman Knott seconded; the motion passed unanimously.

APPROVE A CHANGE TO POLICY RE: SWIMSUIT ATTIRE AT NORTHSIDE POOL, AS RECOMMENDED BY RECREATION BOARD: Mr. Stains noted that there have been numerous complaints this year about swim attire (thongs being worn by teens under the age of 18), etc. Discussions have been held by the Recreation Board and

they are recommending a change in policy as follows: "The following attire is prohibited, both in the pool and in public areas of the pool premises: thong-style, transparent, see-through, or otherwise revealing swimwear. Patrons who fail to comply with these standards may be asked to leave the facility." Several questions were raised, and Solicitor Wisner suggested that the matter be discussed further in executive session.

Council moved to executive session at 6:46 p.m. They reconvened to regular session at 7:46 p.m.

Councilman J. Fleagle made a motion to adopt the proposed policy regarding swimsuit attire, as outlined previously. Councilman P. Fleagle seconded; the motion passed unanimously.

APPROVE HIRING OF FULL-TIME FIRE CHIEF: Councilman Cermak made a motion to approve the hiring of Christopher Devers as full-time Fire Chief (exempt employee), contingent upon the successful completion of his background investigations and required evaluations. Councilman Knott seconded; the motion passed unanimously.

Having no further business to discuss, the meeting adjourned at 7:49 p.m. on a P. Fleagle/Knott motion which passed unanimously.
